**-Unintentional - Know the difference -Intentional-**

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Not knowing how to properly quote or cite your research.</li> <li>• Paraphrased work is too close in style to the original (without using quotation marks).</li> </ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Copying someone's work and deliberately presenting it as your own original work.</li> </ul> |
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**"Plagiarizing prevents the teacher from knowing if the student is learning."**
